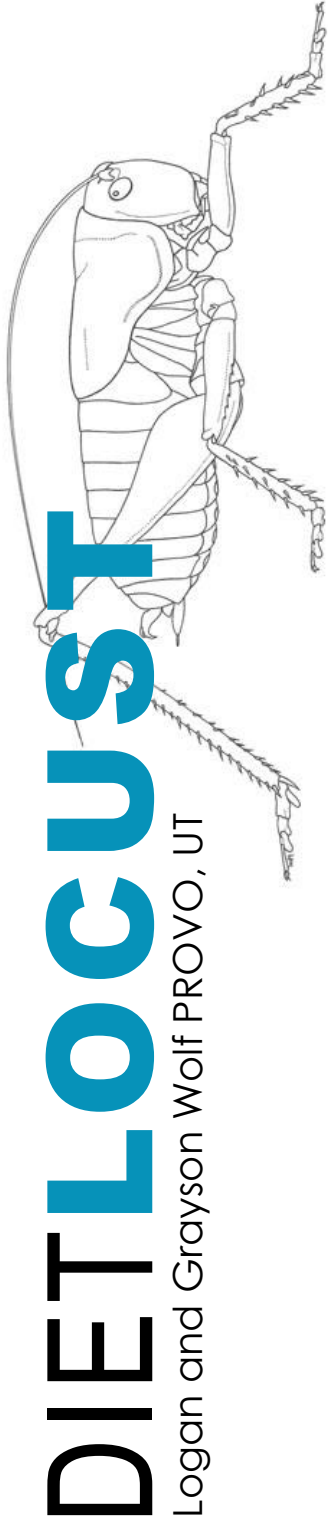


January/February 2012



As I look back over the last nine months (can you believe it's already been nine months?), I am thrilled with what we've been able to accomplish here in Provo and am grateful for the support of individuals and churches such as you who have made it possible.

Grayson and I worked hard to finish last year strong. With the help of a couple visiting from Pleasant Acres FWB Church in New Bern, North Carolina we were able to knock on several hundred doors and conduct two service projects the week before Christmas. I also finished preparations for an advertising campaign that started that same week.

On Christmas day, while we celebrated with Scott and Staci Warren, national home missionaries to Salt Lake City, we had almost 12,000 flyers go out in the newspaper inviting people to church. On January third we sent 155,000 emails to people within thirty miles of our zip code, also inviting them to church. On top of that, we currently have ads in twenty venues across Orem and Provo and have bought ad space in the 2012 Metro Guide that will be distributed in a couple of weeks. I am praying that this goes a long way in supplementing our door to door efforts. While we have yet to see major results from any one method of outreach—no two guests have heard about us the same way—I know you can't go wrong keeping God's Word in front of people.

Currently we are looking forward to a visit from our friends Russ and Samantha Stillman. Russ is the pastor of First FWB Church in Boise, Idaho, a project sponsored by Gateway Global Missions. They'll arrive later this month and stay for four days, including a Sunday. It will be encouraging to have them with us for a service, as our attendance is still quite erratic. Though we continue to see first time guests as well as those that have been once or twice before, there is yet to be anyone I would call a regular attender. It is slow going and there is an enormous amount of work to do.

That is why on *Sunday, February 26 at 6:30pm* Grayson and I will be at Faith FWB Church (1200 West Grantham Street, Goldsboro, North Carolina 27530). While the purpose of our trip back to North Carolina is to see our parents, mine having just returned from Haiti, we are taking advantage of the opportunity Faith is affording us. I will be preaching and sharing the progress of the work, but my emphasis will be our need for help. We are grateful for those groups that have come, or are scheduled to come, to assist us for a few days and hope to book many more. However, it is my prayer that we would find some couples and families to move out here to assist us for longer lengths of time.

I hope you will make plans to attend this service and consider how you might personally get involved in what God is doing in Utah. In the meantime, please keep us and the city of Provo in your prayers, asking God for both laborers and fruit.
